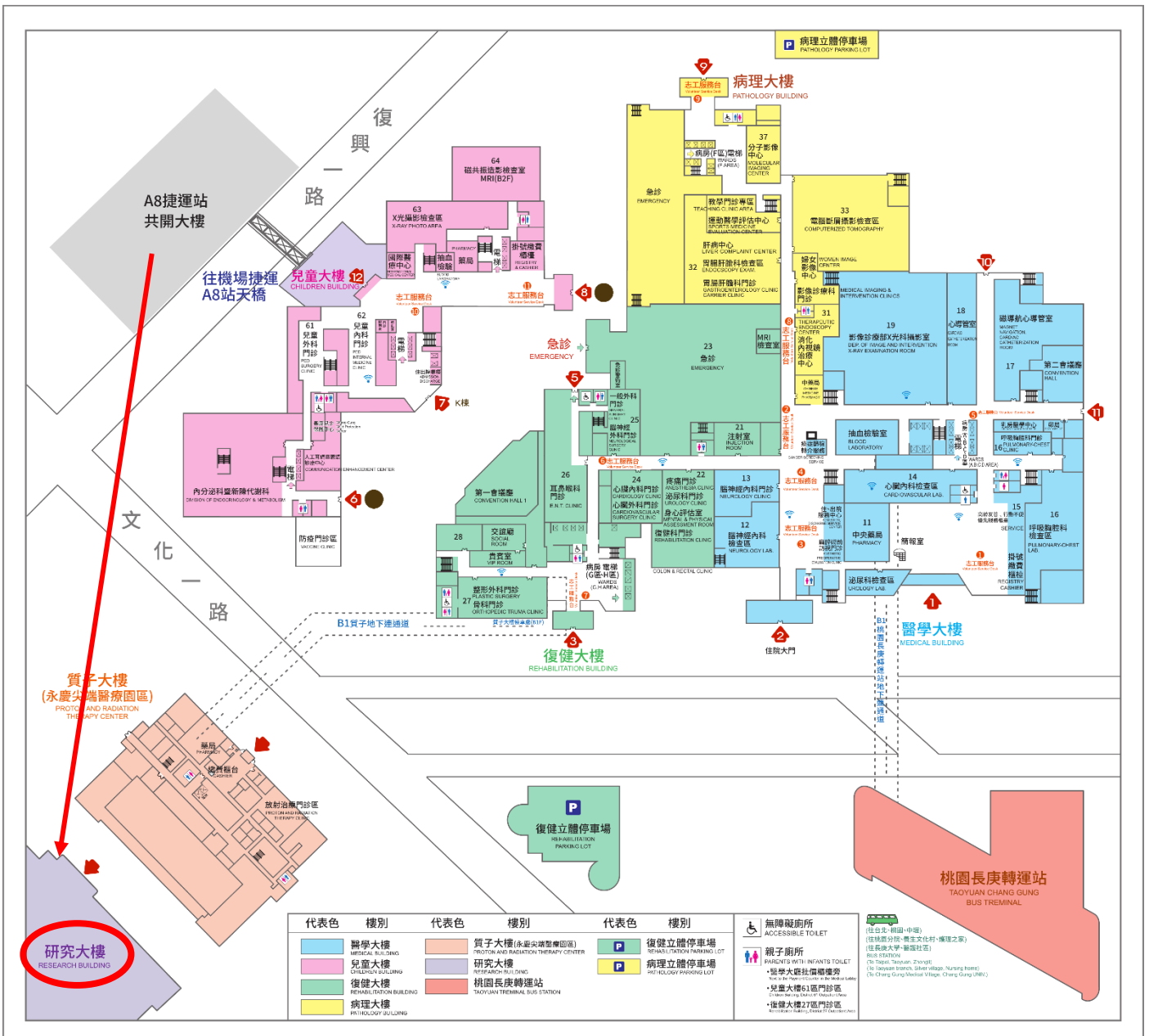

1. By Taoyuan Airport MRT: Chang Gung Memorial Hospital Station (A8)

Take the MRT to Chang Gung Memorial Hospital Station (A8). Turn right onto Wenming Road, walk for about 3 minutes, and then turn left to the Research Building (student volunteers will guide you along the way).

2. By Bus to "Linkou Chang Gung Memorial Hospital Station"

Get off at the "Linkou Chang Gung Memorial Hospital Station" and walk for approximately 7-8 minutes.

3. From Taoyuan Airport to the Venue

Take the Taoyuan Airport MRT from "Airport Terminal 1 Station (A12)" or "Airport Terminal 2 Station (A13)" to "Chang Gung Memorial Hospital Station (A8)." Walk for about 3 minutes.

4. From Taoyuan High-Speed Rail Station to the Venue

Take the Taoyuan Airport MRT from "HSR Taoyuan Station (A18)" to "Chang Gung Memorial Hospital Station (A8)." Walk for about 3 minutes.

5. Driving Directions:

- **Northbound:** Exit at the Linkou Interchange and turn right onto Guangming Road. After passing the CPC gas station, turn left to enter the parking area.
- **Southbound:** Exit at the Linkou Interchange and turn left onto Guangming Road. After passing the CPC gas station, turn left to enter the parking area.
- **Nearby Parking:** Please note that no parking discounts are provided; your understanding is appreciated.

You could print the confirmation slip and show it at the Registration Desk in the conference venue.**

Meals

Oral Presentation Guidelines

- For Moderators: Arrive early at the venue. Before the oral presentations, announce the presentation time limits and rules. You are responsible for maintaining order and managing time for each session.
- For Presenters: Arrive early at the venue for equipment testing. Ensure your presentation includes 10 minutes for presenting and 2 minutes for Q&A.

Poster Presentation Guidelines

- Presentation Language: Traditional Chinese or English, as selected during submission.

- Poster Format: Vertical format, 85 cm (width) × 120 cm (height).
- Posting Time: Posters must be displayed before 10:00 AM on Saturday, December 7 and removed by 4:30 PM.
- Attendance: At least one member of the author group must register for the conference.
- Responsibilities: Authors are responsible for printing, posting, and retrieving their posters.

Certificate of Attendance and Presentation

- Certificates will be sent via email in electronic format after the conference.
